BED HOLD

When Resident is sent out of the facility due to hospitalization at any time, Medicare/



Medicaid does not pay the room and board payment. Resident or Representative may elect to pay the ongoing Medicaid room rate for the room, thus holding a bed until Resident returns. Payments must be made in (5) day increments within the first (24) hours of the hospital admission. There is no limit to how long the facility will continue to accept a payment for bed hold and Facility will never refuse any bed hold payment. Paying bed hold is solely the decision of Resident and/or Resident Representative. If, by chance, a hospitalization is (15) days or less and the bed was not held, the Facility will offer Resident the first available bed at the appropriate level of care required. Any refunds will be paid promptly if an advanced payment is not used.
