ADVANCED DIRECTIVES

The facility recognizes the resident's right to make decisions regarding his/her own treatment and to formulate advance directives, if you have the ability to do so.

In the event a resident is already incapable of making medical decisions or incapable of communication at the time of admission, appropriate decisions will continue to be made in the best interests of the resident. This will be done through the joint efforts of the primary physician, the resident's appointed decision-maker or representative, and the interdisciplinary care team.

A copy of any executed advance directives, if any, will be copied and placed in the clinical record upon admission (living will, health care power of attorney, etc.) so that this information is readily available in the event it is necessary for immediate decisions and care related to medical conditions.

An advance directive is not a requirement of admission to this facility; however, it is strongly encouraged to consider the benefits of having such a document. These decisions can be made at any time; however, it is best if they are ready for immediate need in the event of an emergency situation so that facility staff know what the resident's wishes truly are if they are unable to respond or if the responsible party is not able to be contacted quickly for immediate decisions related to care.
